Job Title: Agriculture/Horticulture Transfer Program Faculty

Contract Length: Part-time as needed. May require evening hours.

Qualifications: 27 graduate quarter hours in Agriculture, Horticulture or a related field. Prefer Master's degree in Agriculture, Horticulture or a related field. Teaching experience in a community college or university setting.

Job Summary: The Agriculture/Horticulture Department at LBCC offers a wide range of courses including Crop Science, Computers in Agriculture, Forage Crops, Marketing in Agriculture, Management in Agriculture, Soils (CSS) and Landscape Plant Materials. The faculty member develops, plans, and presents organized lectures, laboratory activities, and out of class assignments in accordance with approved course outlines.

Essential Duties: Applicants must possess a combination of academic preparation and professional experience that demonstrates the ability to:

1. Imparts excitement and enthusiasm into the teaching of agriculture and horticulture.
2. Develops course schedules and syllabi.
3. Plans, develops, and delivers classroom lectures and activities as well as write tests and develops other methods to evaluate student progress and competence.
4. Develops or adapts laboratory exercises students will find engaging and relevant.
5. Assures lab equipment is properly used and verifies all equipment is present at the end of each laboratory section.
6. Works effectively with students and staff of various cultural and socioeconomic backgrounds and ages and successfully interacts with supervisors, colleagues, and staff as part of an education team.
7. Communicates effectively in oral and written English.
8. Keeps accurate grade and attendance records.
9. Establishes and maintains opportunities for reasonable out-of-class contact with students.
