

# APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION

Thank you for your interest in Linn-Benton Community College. You are eligible for admission if you are a high school graduate, have a GED or are over 18 years of age.

Please be aware that the following programs require "special admission" and you must complete an additional admissions packet: Dental Assistant, Nursing, Occupational Therapy Assistant, Pharmacy Technology, Phlebotomy, Diagnostic Imaging, Polysomnography Technology, Veterinary Assistant. Here's how to complete the process to apply for admission to LBCC:

1. Return a completed admissions application, with the \$30 non-refundable fee, to the Admissions Office, 6500 Pacific Blvd. SW, Albany, OR 97321 or apply online at [www.linnbenton.edu](http://www.linnbenton.edu)
2. If transferring credits from another college or university, have an official transcript sent to LBCC Admissions and complete a Transfer Credit Evaluation Request form, available on our web site at [www.linnbenton.edu/admissions/go/forms](http://www.linnbenton.edu/admissions/go/forms)
3. Make an appointment to take the required placement examination through our Student Assessment Center website at <http://www.timecenter.com/lbcc-test> or complete a placement exam waiver form, available on our admissions website, and attach prior college transcripts showing successful completion with a "C" or better in college composition, algebra and courses with satisfactory college level reading. The placement test may be taken at the Albany campus or our off site locations or at any proctored location.
4. Attend an Orientation/Advising session. You will receive information in the mail on how to sign up to attend. (Please bring an unofficial copy of previous college course work to your advising session). You may also complete orientation on-line if you are outside the community college district. If you have documented disabilities call the office of Disability Services to schedule an intake workshop.
