Mental Health Concerns

The student is experiencing grief/loss or other traumatic event.

Academic/Financial Concerns

Student needs assistance or resources in or outside the classroom.

Student Conduct

Disruptive behavior, academic dishonesty, sexual misconduct

2. FOLLOW UP WITH...

*"Are you getting the support you need for coping with what you are experiencing?"
(e.g. counselor, doctor, supportive friends/family)*

If the student needs additional support from college services...

"Your success is important to me. Can I connect you with some resources that I think will really help you out?"

OR

"Thank you for sharing, that sounds really difficult. Do you mind if someone reaches out to you?"
