On behalf of the Board of Education, I would like to provide an update on the search process to identify the next President of Linn-Benton Community College (LBCC). This week the Presidential Search Committee worked hard, engaged in thoughtful discussion and in the coming weeks will participate in confidential first-round interviews. This is the point in the search process when confidentiality is of paramount importance and we thank you for honoring and respecting the process.

As a reminder, we anticipate that the final candidates will visit LBCC the week of February 17 and participate in public forums, tour the College, meet with direct reports, and interview with the Board of Education. We will announce the final candidates, dates and times of the public forums once confirmed. Everyone who attends a public forum will receive a feedback form. All feedback forms must be returned at the conclusion of each forum. All feedback forms will be shared with the Board of Education as part of their deliberation process.
