

Graduation and Transfer-Out Rates

¹ Because transfer to a four-year school is a significant part of our mission, both graduation and transfer without graduation can be considered a successful outcome and so are presented here as the “Success Rate.”

² The individual sports cohorts consist *only* of full-time students receiving athletically-based financial aid who had not attended college prior to attending LBCC in the fall of 2015. So, this “success rate” represents only Fall, First-time, Full-time Freshmen receiving athletic financial aid, a very small group of students.
