Richard: Update on AGS degree

- Approximately 100 AGS degrees given each year
- 62% only get AGS, 38% get another degree or certificate in addition to AGS degree

- Once a student gets an AGS, 8% return to get a different degree
- Dental Hygiene is #1 Program with AGS degree
- 9% of AGS degree students come in with transfer credits
- Average #of credits AGS students earned = 137 (120 is baseline)
