

ATD Check-in for MERIT 2/6/2015

Initiatives:

Math-

-Boot Camp

2013 held 2 classes before Fall session

2014 Fall session class cancelled due to enrollment

Difficulties to scaling-low enrollment and Fall term is the only time when Boot Camp can be held effectively; advertising, advisor training

-Fast Track-2013 several classes held each quarter

2013 to the end of Fall 2014 92 students had taken Fast Track

Of these 92:

43 students enrolled in a subsequent class; of those, 23 passed with a C or better---a 60% pass rate

Several others did not need to take any more math or they transferred

2015 Winter term has 2 sections offered with 24 in each class; Spring term will also offer 2 classes

Fewer MTH 20 and MTH 60 classes are needed now

Difficulties to scaling-lack of computer labs and/or laptops, advertising, advisor training, appropriate placement

-MTH 98-alternate path to MTH 105

2014 first class offered Fall term 17 students enrolled

Of those 17:

14 earned a C or better, a 78.6% pass rate

Difficulties to scaling- needs more time to develop; buy in by math faculty; college and university policy; advertising; advisor training

Overall concerns: Placement issues; ways to fill in learning gaps/compress sequence; funding for technology
