Emergency Response/Immediate Threat

Emergency:

Person...

- Is a victim of attack
- Appears to pose imminent danger
- Behavior causes you concern for safety



Referral:

**Call Campus Public Safety
541-926-6855 or 411 from
campus phones or 911**



Intervention:

As needed, a Public Safety Officer will respond, manage situation, & Report. The Threat Assessment Team will assess threat/risk. Additional resources called as needed.

Non-Emergencies & Consultation

Student Counseling

- Depression, severe anxiety
- Suicidal thoughts, severe mental health episode, student distress
- Personal loss, grief, high stress

- Behavior violates conduct code
- Disrupts teaching/learning
- Classroom management needs
