- Assess exposures to chemical and physical hazards common in industrial environments.
- Compose reports and present findings.
- Work with the ATI safety data sheet authoring team to update product SDS for ATI customers.
- Assist with data entry and other administrative duties associated with industrial hygiene and other environmental, health, and safety processes.
- Perform and/or coordinate risk assessments and abatement (RA&A), problem solving reports (PSR) & continuous improvement (CI) activities.
- Capital and Major Maintenance project support including capital funding request (CFR) generation, project management, primary technical support on new equipment used in process.
